CDL Class A positions at Brooks Construction Company, Inc. may perform any/all of the following duties:

Utilize their CDL Class A license while using a Distributor, Water Wagon, One Ton, Flatbed, or other commercial motor vehicle with or without a trailer. These positions are on average 25% using a commercial motor vehicle and 75% field crew work. Transport heavy equipment to and from the job site. Load, unload, and clean equipment as directed. Perform traffic control (flagging) duties as required. Place and pick up traffic control materials (cones, barrels, etc.) as needed. Complete daily pre/post-trip inspection checklist. Perform general duties on a Brooks Construction crew in a safe, efficient, and proper manner to achieve a quality finished product. Perform other miscellaneous duties, as directed.

Brooks Construction has 3 different crew types which include: **asphalt paving, concrete, & dirt/pipe.**

Qualifications may include:

- Must have and maintain a valid CDL Class A Driver's License with tanker endorsement
- High School Diploma or GED (or ability to obtain within 12 months of hire) as required per the Union
- Must have reliable transportation with the ability and willingness to travel to and from job sites up to a 70 mile radius from our office (at the employee's expense)
- Must be willing to abide by our Drug & Alcohol Free Workplace policies
- Must be able to work outdoors in all seasons and all weather conditions (including rain, snow, extreme heat or cold, water, mud, dust, etc.)
- Must be willing to work evenings, weekends, and long hours/extensive overtime (sunrise to sunset) when necessary (often with little or no notice)
- Must have exceptional attendance, punctuality, dependability, reliability, and work ethic (including performance record with other/prior employers)
- Must have a "Safety Before Anything" attitude
- Must be able to wear personal protective equipment (PPE) for safety as required
- Must be able to thrive in a fast-paced environment
- Must be able to pick up on procedures quickly
- Must be a Team Player
- Construction, labor, hands-on, outdoor, or related work experience is preferred, but not required
- Must be able to work independently, without continuous supervision/oversight
- Must be able to perform assigned duties and tasks as directed
- Ability to perform the physical functions of the job with or without reasonable accommodation
