## PLANT PUG MILL CONFINED SPACE PROCEDURE

1. The type of work to be performed is routine maintenance?  YES  NO
2. The employee(s) entering the confined space have received the annual training?  YES  NO
3. All necessary personal protective equipment will be used? (Including but not limited to: hardhat, safety glasses, etc.)  YES  NO
4. An attendant (hole watcher) will be stationed outside the space entrance and has secured proper communications with the entrant?  YES  NO
5. Is all work going to be performed by Brooks Construction Co., Inc. employee?  YES  NO
6. The pug mill has been completely locked out? (Including but not limited to: blades, gates, electricity, gas valves, hydraulic, air and etc.)  YES  NO
7. A manlift will be used as required to access the pug mill and all operators that use this piece of equipment will be trained and provided with fall protection?  YES  NO
8. Ventilation may be used before and during confined space work to cause a positive air flow?  YES  NO

***Note: Fall Protection and lifeline will not be required if manlift basket is flush with gates below the pug mill because of the additional hazards.***
