- Maintaining a strong knowledge of Brooks Construction's quality control plan (QC/QA plan) and its execution.
- Collaborate with the asphalt paving foreman by providing testing data as work is in process, which allows foreman to make necessary adjustments.
- Communicating with asphalt paving foremen, superintendents, QC/QA manager, QC/QA technicians, asphalt roller operators, and INDOT/owner personnel.
- Operating, calibrating, and maintaining highly sensitive asphalt pavement testing equipment.
- Maintaining various records, including temperature logs, density testing logs, and coring result logs.
- Personally perform other various crew duties, as directed.

Perform general labor duties on a Brooks Construction crew in a safe, efficient, and proper manner to achieve a quality finished product. Perform other miscellaneous duties, as directed.

Quality Pavement Tech Laborers are typically utilized on **asphalt paving** crews.

Qualifications may include:

- Must have good basic math skills for calculating percentages
- Must be willing to work evenings, weekends, and long hours/extensive overtime (sunrise to sunset) when necessary (often with little or no notice)
- Must be able to work outdoors in all seasons and all weather conditions (including rain, snow, extreme heat or cold, water, mud, dust, etc.)
- Must have reliable transportation with the ability and willingness to travel to and from job sites up to a 70 mile radius from our office (at the employee's expense)
- Must have and maintain a valid driver's license
- Must be willing to abide by our Drug & Alcohol Free Workplace policies
- Must have exceptional attendance, punctuality, dependability, reliability, and work ethic (including performance record with other/prior employers)
- Must have strong communication and interpersonal skills for working with internal and external customers
- Must have strong decision-making and problem solving skills
- Must have a "Safety Before Anything" attitude
- Must be able to wear personal protective equipment (PPE) for safety as required
- Must be able to thrive in a fast-paced environment
- Must be able to pick up on procedures quickly
